Dear John Tapia:

This is your formal notification that facilities owned by **WEST SOUND** are in conflict with the SR 160 / Long Lake Rd SE – Roundabout Project and may require relocation.

This notification letter provides descriptions of the PROJECT scope, PROJECT milestones, and **WEST SOUND** franchising and permitting requirements.

PROJECT Scope

The PROJECT proposes to install a roundabout at the intersection on SR 160 and Long Lake Rd SE MP 2.54 to MP 2.56 to improve traffic operations and reduce the frequency and severity of collisions at this intersection.

Enclosed are a preliminary Utility Conflict Plan for your reference.

PROJECT Milestones

WSDOT milestones for the PROJECT:

January 2025 - Advertise Contract

TBD - Construction Notice to Proceed

TBD - Project Completion

Permits or Franchises

If **WEST SOUND** facilities occupy the property by a city, county, or state franchise, permit, or ordinance, **WEST SOUND** does not possess a compensable real property interest, and, therefore, is responsible for the relocation costs of its facilities that are in conflict with the PROJECT. WSDOT will be responsible for costs to resolve conflict of **WEST SOUND** facilities with the PROJECT only if **WEST SOUND** owns a compensable real property interest in the property which its facilities occupy. To prove such an interest, **WEST SOUND** must provide WSDOT one of the following:

- a deed showing fee title in ownership to the property
- a deed showing easement rights to use the property
- a court finding a prescriptive easement rights

Currently, **WEST SOUND**'s facilities reside on SR 160 right of way under WSDOT Utility Franchise #**UF-OL-2023-004**.

In the prosecution of the relocation work, **WEST SOUND** and its contractors shall work diligently and

in good faith to coordinate their work and resolve all issues as not to delay the PROJECT.

WEST SOUND is fully responsible to acquire all necessary permits and approvals for its relocation work, including environmental documentation and permitting. WSDOT expects that WEST SOUND will determine its permitting needs and apply for permits in a timely manner to ensure that permit timelines will not delay the relocation work. WEST SOUND shall notify WSDOT immediately if there are concerns regarding the acquisition of permits or easement rights in time to meet relocation deadlines.

Please note, should your organization not timely commence, execute, and complete any adjustment and/or relocation work as determined necessary for the PROJECT, PSE may be held responsible for construction and delay costs incurred during the PROJECT.

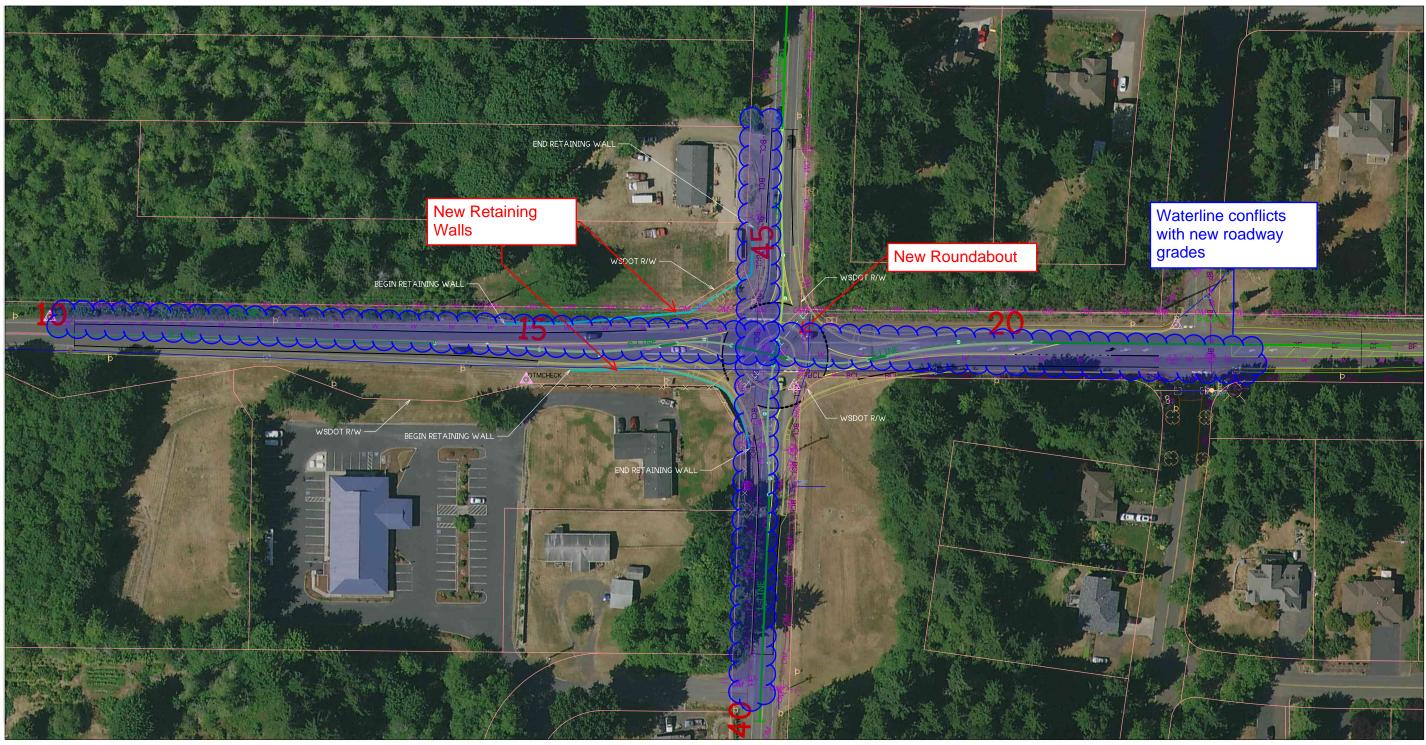

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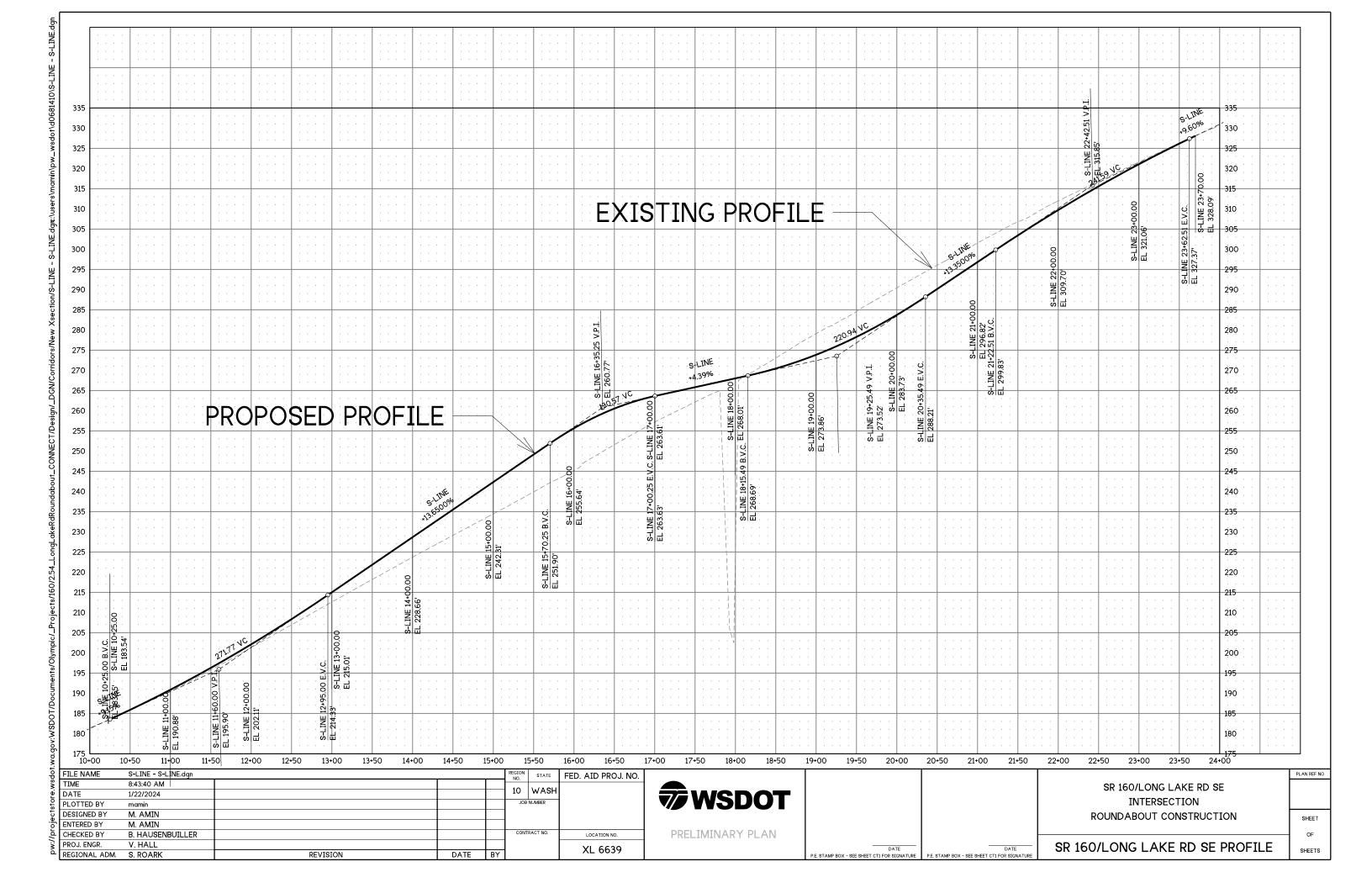

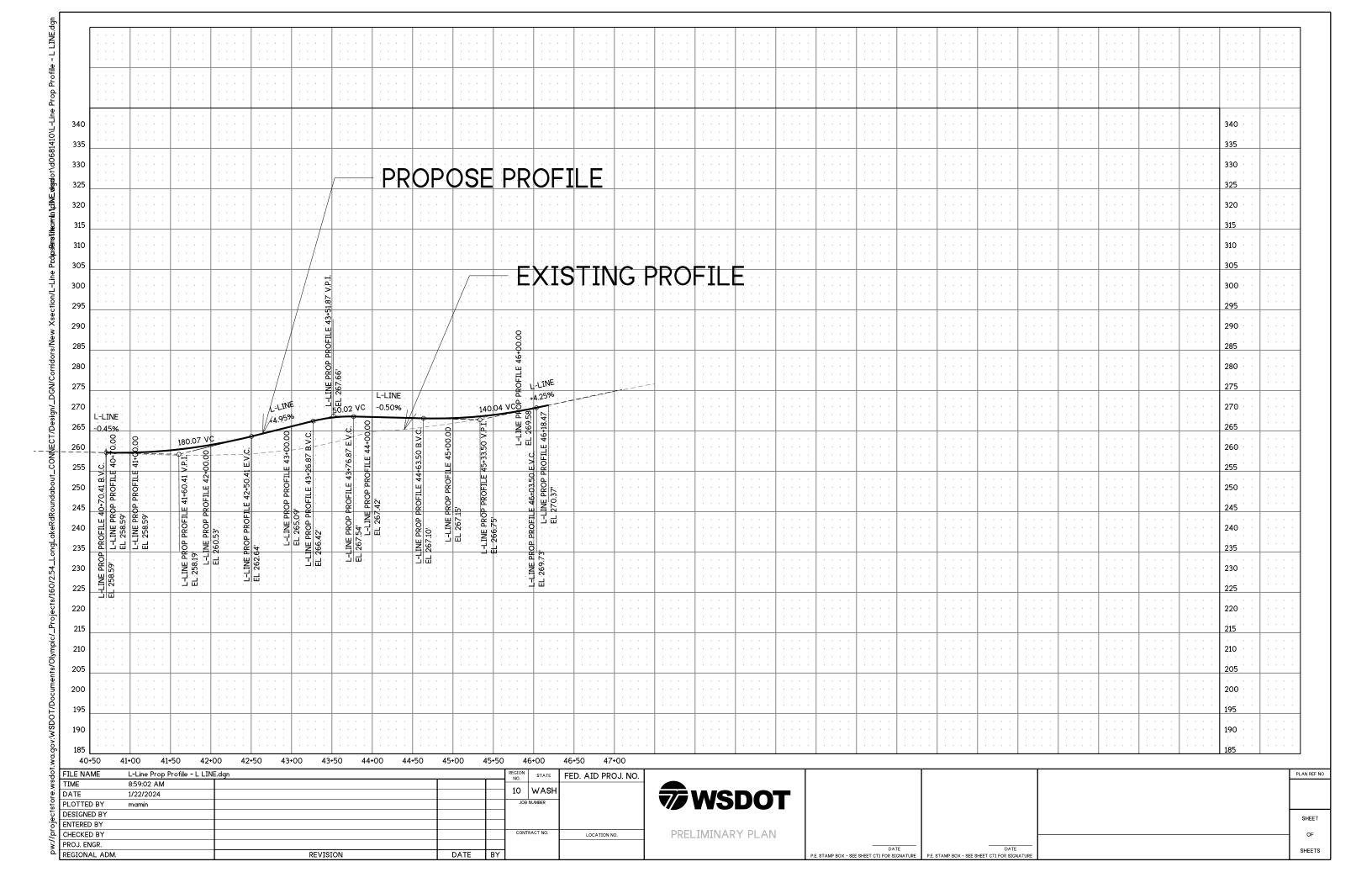

A RESOLUTION OF THE WEST SOUND UTILITY DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS APPROVING EQUIPMENT PURCHASE OF A LIFT STATION PUMP FOR THE BLUEBERRY LIFT STATION

WHEREAS, the WSUD 2024 Wastewater Capital Improvement Budget contains funding for replacement equipment to address needs for Lift Stations; and

WHEREAS, a spare pump for the Blueberry Lift Station is needed in case of a pump failure where timeliness of replacement would be required; and

WHEREAS, the District solicited a proposal from Whitney Equipment to provide the District with the spare pump for the Blueberry Lift Station; and

WHEREAS, Whitney Equipment is a sole source provider for specific equipment needed (Flyght Pump) by the District for the identified Lift Station; and

WHEREAS, the amount for this purchase is in excess of the \$20,000.00 contracting purchasing authority of the General Manager; and requires the approval of the Board of Commissioners; **NOW**, **THEREFORE**,

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WEST SOUND UTILITY DISTRICT HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. The District's Board of Commissioners hereby approve the attached quote/contract for the equipment supply from Whitney Equipment as identified in Exhibit "A" in the amount of \$29,960.00 plus freight (\$545.00) and WSST (\$2,756.32) for a total of \$33,261.32. The Board further authorizes the General Manager to sign the purchase contract.

This Contract prevails over any terms and conditions of purchase provided by Buyer, regardless of whether or when the Buyer has submitted its purchase order or such terms. In addition, implied terms and conditions from the Buyer's contracts with other entities are not valid or enforceable with respect this Contract. Fulfillment of the Buyer's order does not constitute acceptance of any of Buyer's terms and conditions and does not serve to modify or amend this Contract.

GOVERNING LAWS: Seller will comply with all laws applicable to Seller during sale of the products. Buyer will comply with all laws applicable to Buyer during operation or use of the products. The laws of the State of Washington shall govern the validity, interpretation, and enforcement of any order of which these provisions are a part, without giving effect to any rules governing the conflict of laws. Assignment may be made only with written consent of both parties. Buyer shall be liable to the Seller for any attorney's fees and costs incurred by Seller in enforcing any of its rights hereunder. Unless otherwise specified, any reference to Buyer's order is for identification only.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE: Any legal suit, action or proceeding arising out of relating to this Contract shall be commended in federal or state court located King County, Washington and Seller and Buyer (i) irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of any such court in any such suit, action or proceeding and (ii) irrevocably waive (to the extent permitted by applicable law) any objection which they now or hereafter may have to the laying of venue of any such action or proceeding brought in any of the foregoing courts in and of the State of Washington, and any objection on the ground that any such action or proceeding in any such court has been brought in an inconvenient forum.

ATTORNEYS FEES AND EXPERT COSTS: The prevailing party in any legal suit, action, or proceeding arising out of relating to the Contract shall be awarded its reasonable attorneys' fees and experts costs.

WARRANTY:

THE SELLER MAKES NO WARRANTIES ON ANY PRODUCTS OR SERVICES PROVIDED UNDER THIS CONTRACT, INCLUDING ANY (A) WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, (B) WARRANTY OF FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, OR (C) WARRANTY AGAINST INFRINGEMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS OF A THIRD PARTY, WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED BY LAW, COURSE OF DEALING, COURSE OF PERFORMANCE, USAGE OF TRADE OR OTHERWISE. BUT THE BUYER SHALL RECEIVE WARRANTIES, IF ANY, PROVIDED BY THE MANUFACTURER OF THE PRODUCTS SOLD UNDER THIS CONTRACT. THE SELLER IS EXPRESSLY EXCLUDED FROM ANY WARRANTY AND ALL CHARGES, FOR LABOR, INSTALLATION, REMOVAL, REPAIR, REINSTALLATION, SHIPPING, UTILITIES, EQUIPMENT RENTAL, OTHER REQUIRED MATERIALS, OR ANY OTHER ITEMS. THE PARTIES AGREE THAT THE BUYER'S SOLE AND EXCLUSIVE REMEDIES SHALL BE AGAINST THE PRODUCT MANUFACTURER AS PROVIDED HEREIN. THE BUYER AGREES THAT NO OTHER REMEDY (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES FOR LOST PROFITS, LOST SALES, DOWN TIME, OPERATING OR MAINTENANCE COSTS, INJURY TO PERSONS OR PROPERTY, OR ANY OTHER SPECIAL, INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL LOSS) SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO BUYER. Any taxes not included in the Bid Quote will be added to the Contract Price. In lieu of paying such taxes to the Seller, the Buyer may furnish the Seller with a Tax Exemption Certificate or other legal and appropriate taxing authorities at any time.

PAYMENT TERMS: All quotations or proposals are in US Dollars unless explicitly stated otherwise in writing. Seller shall submit invoices for payment to Buyer for percentages of the Contract Price as described in Bid Quote. Buyer must pay all invoices submitted by Seller no later than 30 days after the date of the invoice, the shipment is delayed by the Buyer, date of readiness for shipment shall be deemed the date of shipment for payment purposes. The Seller may require advance payment or a certificate of deposit, or may otherwise modify credit terms, should the Buyer's credit standing not meet the Seller's requirements. A service charge of 2.5% per month on the unpaid balance will be charged on all overdue monies payable. Buyer shall not assign or transfer their contract or any interest in it, or monies payable under it, without the written consent of Seller and any assignment made without such consent shall be null and void. Buyer agrees to pay all collection costs and costs of suit, including reasonable attorney fees, in the event Seller institutes collection action for overdue account. Seller expressly reserves all available lien rights in connection with any transaction between the parties. Unless explicitly agreed upon in writing, retainage against the contract amount is not allowed. WEST SOUND UTILITY DISTRICT RESOLUTION 1125-24

A RESOLUTION OF THEWEST SOUND UTILITY DISTRICT BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AMENDING WATER POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the District Board of Commissioners adopts sewer and water policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the District has reviewed its current water policies and procedures and has determined it is necessary to amend some of the water policies and procedures; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WEST SOUND UTILITY DISTRICT HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Board of Commissioners hereby amends the water policies and procedures, Section 9.1 Water Connection Charges and Fees as follows:

9.1 Water Connection Charges and Fees

- A. **Property on Which Connection Charges Imposed** Owners of real property within or outside the District seeking to connect improvements of such real property to the District's water system, shall pay, as a condition of the District's grant of the right to so connect, connection charges as established so the property owner bears an equitable share of the cost of the District's water system. In addition, the property owner will also be required to pay the cost of making the connection and the cost of a water meter. The General Facility fees shall be paid in full at the time of issuance of the Binding Water Availability Letter.
- B. **General Facilities Charge** Owners of real property seeking to connect to the District's water system shall pay a general facilities charge based on meter size.

The General Facility Charge shall generally be adjusted annually to account for inflation. The inflation factor shall be based on the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index (ENR-CCI), Seattle, WA for June of each year. If the ENR-CCI is less than zero percent (0%), the fees shall not be changed for that year. The effective date of each annual ENR-CCI adjustment shall be January 1st of each year.

The definition and method of calculation for each customer class shall be as follows:

- 1. **Residential Class** The residential class consists of single family, accessory dwelling and duplex units. The charge for residential class shall be assessed for each residential living unit.
- 2. **Multifamily Class** The multifamily class consists of residential buildings with

three or more dwelling units, including nursing homes and accessory building with a kitchen. The charge for multifamily class shall be assessed for each residential dwelling unit. A separate meter shall be required for each dwelling complex or business building; however, in the case of multifamily units, the District may require one or more service connections and meters for each multifamily unit, and charges shall be in accordance with the District's current meter and general facility charges schedule.

- 3. **Commercial Class** The commercial class consists of any business, church, or government facility. The charge for commercial class shall be assessed based on the meter size for each building.
- 4. **Institutional Class** The institutional class consists of public schools. The charge for institutional class shall be assessed based on the meter size for each building.

5. Irrigation Class

- a. General Irrigation The general irrigation class consists of real property that is irrigated and does not satisfy the requirements of Drought Tolerant Irrigation.
- b. **Drought Tolerant Irrigation** The drought tolerant irrigation class consists of real property that has Land Use Authority landscape plans identifying the real property landscaping as drought and showing a low water use irrigation system, such as drip irrigation.

The General Facility Charge for irrigation meters shall be paid in addition to the General Facility Charge for residential, industrial, multifamily and commercial classes.

C. Change of Use Upon any change in use or meter size, the owner of the real property shall notify the District. With any change in use or meter size, the property owner will be required to pay the difference between the general facilities charge for the current meter size and the charge for the proposed meter size.

D. Water Service Connection Charges

1. **Full Service Installation Charge** For meters and related appurtenances installed by the District, including road crossings, the following charges shall be levied and collected at the time of service application:

Full service installations will be installed on a time and materials basis. A deposit paid to the District based on estimated cost will be required prior to installation. The District General Manager is authorized to adopt a schedule of the deposit and the hourly and material charges, which shall be posted in the District office.

2. **Pre-Installed Service (Meter Only)** The fees for the installation of a meter only apply when the service connection and all associated valves, fittings, meter setters, etc. have already been installed in accordance with the District's specifications, at the expense of the property owner.

3. Pre-Installed Service (With Meter 1.50" and Larger Only) The fees for the installation of a meter only apply when the service connection and all associated valves, fittings, meter setters, meter etc. have already been installed in accordance with the District's specifications, at the expense of the property owner. Meters installed under this criterion (1.50" and larger) may be prior to conveyance of installed infrastructure to the District to allow for correct setter sizing on adjustable setters. The District will install a lock on the applicable setter for the bypass and meter and no water service shall be allowed and therefore utility billing will not commence until the infrastructure is accepted by the Board of Commissioners and the District has initiated the service.
